### RECOMMENDATION

### CONCLUSION

The crime statistics for the month of January 2011 reflect a decrease in Crimes Against the Person of 25.2% compared to January 2010, with Crimes Against Property showing a 19.9% decrease compared to January 2010.

### BACKGROUND

Each month, reports providing statistics for the City of Regina are presented to the Board for their review and information. This report will provide statistics for the month of January 2011. The Communications Centre statistics are included showing the total calls for service. An addition to the statistical extract this year is the inclusion of non-dispatched calls for service.

### DISCUSSION

Crimes Against Property continue to decline, with a reduction in the number of incidents. Year-to-date there are 177 fewer reported incidents for an overall decrease of 19.9%. We have seen a year-to-date reduction of 64 reported incidents of Theft Under \$5000 for a 15.5% decrease. The Regina Police Service is paying close attention to emerging trends in Crimes Against Property and applying crime prevention and enforcement measures where appropriate.

Thefts of Motor Vehicles show a decrease of 8.0% in our year-to-date statistics. The Regina Police Service in conjunction with its partners in the Stolen Auto Strategy continues to pay constant attention to this issue.

There has been a year-to-date decrease of 52 incidents of Mischief / Wilful Damage for a decrease of 27.8%.

32 fewer Break and Enter incidents were reported this January than last January, marking a reduction of 26.7%

Crimes Against the Person reflect a year-to-date decrease of 71 incidents over January 2010, for a 25.2% decrease. 32 Robberies were reported in January 2011, matching the 32 reported in January 2010.

Overall the Regina Police Service received 248 fewer reports of Crimes Against the Person and Crimes Against Property combined in January 2011 than it did in January 2010.

48 more incidents of Impaired Driving were reported by the Regina Police Service in January 2011 than were reported in January 2010, marking an increase of 369.2%. This does not reflect an increase in the number of impaired drivers, but instead reflects an increased strategic focus on impaired driving, including the implementation of the Report Impaired Driving partnership.

Total dispatched calls for service increased by 6.2%, with a decrease in alarm calls of 4.4%. Non-dispatched calls for service decreased by 12.7%. Total calls for service in January 2011 (including dispatched and non-dispatched calls) were 1.4% lower in than they were in January 2010.
