<i>Age:</i>	Over 18 years of age
<i>Education:</i>	Complete Grade 12 or Grade 12 Equivalent Must hold current Standard First Aid and CPR (Level "C") Certification
<i>Visual Acuity:</i>	Uncorrected visual acuity of: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 20/60 in both eyes or better; <i>or</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 20/40 in one eye and 20/100 in the other eye or better without visual aids, correctable to 20/20 or 20/30. No marked degree of colour blindness
<i>Citizenship:</i>	Canadian Citizenship or Permanent Residency Status. Applicants with Temporary Work Permits will not be accepted.
<i>Examinations:</i>	Able to pass written, medical and physical examinations Have a good command of English, both written and oral Be in possession of a valid Motor Vehicle Operator's License

<i>REGINA:</i>	Must be 19 years of age or older. No criminal record and be free from criminal involvement in three (3) preceding years, e.g. thefts, illegal drugs. Applicants with at least two years' post secondary education and/or an extended period of work experience with increasing performance responsibilities will be given prior consideration. Applicant must agree to submit to a polygraph examination. Applicants whose visual acuity has been corrected by laser eye surgery will not be considered until three months prior to Selection Board Interviews.
